## Utilities

Remember to take meter readings on the day you move for:

- Gas
- Electricity
- Water

Contact your providers of the following to ensure you'll be up and running the day you move in.

- Landline
- Mobile phone
- Satellite / cable
- Broadband
- TV License

## Financial

Moving home can be a good time to review your finances. Consider;

- Bank/Building
- Society Accounts
- Credit Cards
- Pensions
- Insurances
- HMRC
- Loyalty Cards
- Premium Bonds
- Any benefits

## Medical

Ensure you are still registered with the following in your new area:

- Doctors
- Dentists
- Optician
- Hospital

To find out about services and contacts in your new area log on to Up My Street.

## Mail

Arrange your mail forwarding with Royal Mail.

## DVLA

Notify the DVLA of your change of address or you risk a fine.

### Top Tip

Contact your car insurance provider to update your home address as it may affect your premium.

## Council

Ensure the following are updated or arranged in your new area:

- Recycling Bins
- Council Tax
- Electoral Roll
- Schools & Childcare

## Your work (HR records)

Ensure your employer's HR and payroll records are updated with your new address, including pension details, benefits information and any workplace emergency contact records.
